



## Billeting Family Responsibilities

### New Zealand Ice Hockey Federation

This document is to outline the responsibilities for billeting families for all Under-18 players involved in a billeting situation, for NZIHF sanctioned events.

Billeting families' responsibilities and expectations include:

- Transporting the hosted player to and from the airport and the ice rink
- Ensuring the player is at his/her games at times determined by the team manager
- Ensuring the player is given suitable meals at the host family's expense
- Ensuring the player has his/her own bed for the night
- Ensuring the player is supervised by a responsible adult at all times
- Ensuring that the players is not permitted to access either alcohol or drugs (other than his/her own prescription medication) at any time
- In the case of illness or accident, ensuring that the player receives necessary medical care promptly and the parent/caregiver of the player and the team manager are informed

All billeting families must also confirm that they have never had any criminal convictions, been investigated or be currently under investigation by New Zealand Police or any other authority with regards to criminal activities.
